QUESTIONS

INTENT

How shall St. George's sustain and evolve its mission into the future?

STEWARDSHIP

- What is an appropriate synthesis of preservation and change?
- What is a desirable approach to the graveyard and courtyard?

LOCATION

- Is it important to have all current functions and activites on-site?
- If any current or future activity were to move off-site, where would it go?

ACCESSIBILITY

- How to make the facility as welcoming as the St. George's community?
- Is it possible to (re)configure entrance(s) and improve internal circulation?

POSSIBILITIES

CHURCH

- The Nave and Gallery are unchanged.
- The North Narthex window is modified for a new accessible entrance.

SYDNOR HALL

- The George Street entrance doors are made ADA compliant.
- The Fellowship Hall is refined to improve larger and smaller group use.
- A new passageway connects existing stair and lift for improved circulation.
- Kitchen relocation enables functionality improvements to Fellowship Hall.
- Storage is enlarged and reconfigured.

FAULKNER HALL

- The Princess Anne Street entrance becomes the main Visitor Entrance.
- Current Meeting Room becomes Reception and Administrative offices.

McGUIRE HALL

- A new elevator connects all levels of McGuire and Faulkner Halls.
- New Catechesis Atria spaces are added at 1 (no off-site space needed).
- New Kitchen and Storage at 2 connect directly to Sydnor Hall.
- New Meeting Room(s) at 2 expand outreach + admin capacity.
- New Meeting Room + Terrace at 3 replace Faulkner Hall meeting space.
- Selected interior renovations improve circulation and functionality.

GRAVEYARD + COURTYARD

- Graves are surveyed, analyzed and a conservation plan is developed.
- Graveyard is reduced in size by the addition to McGuire Hall.
- A new Church entrance ramp is inserted into the corner of the Graveyard.
